Chef Samone (Atlanta, GA) first experienced her passion for cooking at the age of 9, which started with her grandmother and dad teaching her the family recipes. As a young girl learning how to mix seasonings, Samone continues to build her career around her passion for *food, people and creating high quality dining experiences.*

Coming from a family that served in the United States Military, at the age of 18 Samone enlisted into the US Army as a Food Specialist stationed in Germany. There she was exposed to kitchen management, food service, and cooking for large quantities of people. Having received her degree in Hospitality and Tourism and also graduating from Le Cordon Bleu in Orlando, Chef Samone finished culinary school. Inspired to be an entrepreneur she started servicing clients as a personal chef. In 2003 Samone founded Wishful Concepts Catering which initially provided in home personal chef services. It quickly grew into a full service catering company providing dining experiences for weddings, corporate functions and festive occasions.

Just as her company was taking off, her previous marriage, clients and business fell apart while experiencing a season of instability due to homelessness in 2004. By Samone journaling her experiences, overcoming a suicide attempt and surviving homelessness, her documented journey eventually transformed into a biography. Chef Samone later wrote about her personal challenges in her spiritual memoir titled *Lily In The Valley* published in 2007. Her personal journey and passion for women, inspired her to build an award winning catering company that serves people from all walks of life.

Samone has appeared on two Food Network competition shows: *Food Network Star Season 14* and *Cooks vs. Cons Season 5*, is an author, certified life coach, culinary leader, speaker, and entrepreneur passionate about how food makes people feel. Chef Samone is eager to share her experiences and support other women who are on their road to greatness in the world of culinary and hospitality.
